Explanation of Local Expenditures: *Summary:* The Lake County Election Board would likely make minimal adjustments to their election budget to print school board member ballots during general elections.

Background: The Lake Station Community School Corporation has five board members. The members' terms are staggered in a two-three format. Terms for two members expired after June 30, 2010. The remaining three members' terms expire after June 30, 2012. Three board members are elected from designated districts, and two are elected at large.
