Summary of Legislation: This bill allows the Alcohol and Tobacco Commission (ATC) to issue a liquor wholesaler's permit to a person who, at the time the person applies for the liquor wholesaler's permit: (1) has been the holder of a beer wholesaler's permit for at least five years; and (2) is the holder of a wine wholesaler's permit.

Effective Date: July 1, 2011.

Explanation of State Expenditures:

Explanation of State Revenues: *Permit Fee Revenue:* This bill allows the ATC to issue a liquor wholesaler's permit to a person who has been the holder of a beer wholesaler's permit for at least five years; and is the holder of a wine wholesaler's permit. This bill could increase permit fee revenues deposited in the state General Fund and the Enforcement and Administration Fund. The amount of the increase is indeterminable and will depend on the number of such permits issued. The annual fee for a liquor wholesaler's permit is \$2,000.
