I move that House Bill 1003 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 2, between lines 24 and 25, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 7. IC 20-43-1-7, AS ADDED BY P.L.2-2006, SECTION
- 3 166, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
- 4 1, 2011]: Sec. 7. "ADM of the previous year" means the ~~initial~~ **last**
- 5 computed ADM for the school year ending in the preceding calendar
- 6 year.
- 7 SECTION 8. IC 20-43-1-10, AS ADDED BY P.L.2-2006,
- 8 SECTION 166, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 9 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 10. "Current ADM" means, **for**
- 10 **distributions made after the date of an ADM count or an adjusted**
- 11 **ADM count**, the ~~initial~~ **last** computed ADM for the school year ending
- 12 in the calendar year.
- 13 SECTION 9. IC 20-43-4-2, AS ADDED BY P.L.2-2006, SECTION
- 14 166, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
- 15 1, 2011]: Sec. 2. A school corporation's ADM is the number of eligible
- 16 pupils enrolled in:
- 17 (1) the school corporation; or
- 18 (2) a transferee corporation;
- 19 on ~~a day~~ **days** to be fixed ~~annually~~ by the state board and as
- 20 subsequently adjusted ~~not later than January 30~~ under the rules adopted
- 21 by the state board.
- 22 SECTION 10. IC 20-43-4-3, AS ADDED BY P.L.2-2006,
- 23 SECTION 166, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 24 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 3. **(a) Subject to subsection (c), the**

- 1 initial day of the ADM count must fall within the first thirty (30) days
2 of the school year. ~~However;~~
3 **(b) The state board shall monitor changes that occur in the**
4 **ADM of a school corporation after the initial fall ADM count. The**
5 **state board shall:**
6 **(1) before the third Friday in January of the following year;**
7 **and**
8 **(2) before the third Friday in April of the following year;**
9 **make an adjusted ADM count of students.**
10 **(c) If extreme patterns of:**
11 (1) student in-migration;
12 (2) illness;
13 (3) natural disaster; or
14 (4) other unusual conditions in a particular school corporation's
15 enrollment;
16 on either the day fixed by the state board or on the subsequent
17 adjustment date, cause the enrollment to be unrepresentative of the
18 school corporation's enrollment throughout a school year, the state
19 board may designate another day for determining the school
20 corporation's enrollment."
21 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
