MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 363 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 6, between lines 22 and 23, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 5. IC 20-28-5-8, AS AMENDED BY P.L.121-2009,
- 3 SECTION 10, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 4 JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 8. (a) This section applies when a prosecuting
- 5 attorney knows that a licensed employee of a public school or a
- 6 nonpublic school has been convicted of an offense listed in subsection
- 7 (c). The prosecuting attorney shall immediately give written notice of
- 8 the conviction to the following:
- 9 (1) The state superintendent.
- 10 (2) Except as provided in subdivision (3), the superintendent of
- 11 the school corporation that employs the licensed employee or the
- 12 equivalent authority if a nonpublic school employs the licensed
- 13 employee.
- 14 (3) The presiding officer of the governing body of the school
- 15 corporation that employs the licensed employee, if the convicted
- 16 licensed employee is the superintendent of the school corporation.
- 17 (b) The superintendent of a school corporation, presiding officer of
- 18 the governing body, or equivalent authority for a nonpublic school shall
- 19 immediately notify the state superintendent when the individual knows
- 20 that a current or former licensed employee of the public school or
- 21 nonpublic school has been convicted of an offense listed in subsection
- 22 (c), or when the governing body or equivalent authority for a nonpublic
- 23 school takes any final action in relation to an employee who engaged
- 24 in any offense listed in subsection (c).

1 (c) The department, after holding a hearing on the matter, shall
 2 permanently revoke the license of a person who is known by the
 3 department to have been convicted of any of the following felonies:

10 specified in IC 20-28-7-7.
11 ~~(f)~~ **(f)** The department shall develop a data base of information on
12 school corporation employees who have been reported to the
13 department under this section."
