DIGEST OF HB 1402 (Updated February 8, 2011 11:22 am - DI 109)

**Citations Affected:** IC 21-14.

**Synopsis:** Prohibiting resident tuition for illegal aliens. Provides that an individual who is not lawfully in the United States is not eligible to pay the resident tuition rate that is determined by the state educational institution.

**Effective:** July 1, 2011.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 21-14-11 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE  
2 AS A **NEW** CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
3 JULY 1, 2011]:

4 **Chapter 11. Restrictions on Resident Tuition**

5 **Sec. 1. An individual who is not lawfully present in the United**  
6 **States is not eligible to pay the resident tuition rate that is**  
7 **determined by the state educational institution.**
