A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION fixing the date for the first regular technical session of the One Hundred Seventeenth General Assembly.

Whereas, IC 2-2.1-1-2.5 authorizes the General Assembly to fix a date for the first regular technical session of the General Assembly;

Whereas, the General Assembly finds that it is in the best interest of the State of Indiana to fix a date for the Technical Session;

Whereas, it is prudent to allow the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate to jointly order that the Technical Session not convene if they determined its cost and inconvenience do not justify meeting in Technical Session: Now, therefore,

the Senate concurring:*

1 SECTION 1. The date for the Technical Session of the One
2 Hundred Seventeenth General Assembly is hereby fixed for Tuesday,
