### DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 3-8-1-32.

**Synopsis:** Age of candidate for state convention delegate. Provides that a person who will be 18 years old by the date of a general, municipal, or special election is entitled to be a candidate for delegate to a state convention that nominates candidates for offices to be voted on at that general, municipal, or special election.

**Effective:** July 1, 2011.

## SENATE BILL No. 82



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning elections.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 3-8-1-32 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
 2 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 32. **(a) Except as provided in**  
 3 **subsection (b)**, a candidate for:  
 4 (1) precinct committeeman; or  
 5 (2) delegate to a state convention;  
 6 of a political party in the state whose nominee received at least ten  
 7 percent (10%) of the total vote cast for secretary of state at the last  
 8 election must comply with any candidate requirement set by state party  
 9 rules.  
 10 **(b) Notwithstanding any state party rule to the contrary, a**  
 11 **person who will meet the age requirements of IC 3-7-13-1 on the**  
 12 **date of a general, municipal, or special election is entitled to be a**  
 13 **candidate for delegate to a state convention that nominates**  
 14 **candidates for offices to be voted on at that general, municipal, or**  
 15 **special election.**
