DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 24-4-6-1.

Synopsis: Sales of motorcycles on Sunday. Permits the purchase, sale, or trade of motorcycles on Sunday. (Current law provides that a person who buys, sells, or trades motor vehicles, including motorcycles, on Sunday commits a Class B misdemeanor.)

Effective: July 1, 2011.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning trade regulation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 24-4-6-1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.156-2006,
 2 SECTION 24, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 3 JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 1. (a) This section does not apply to **the**
 4 **following:**
 5 (1) A person that holds a special event permit issued under
 6 IC 9-23-2-16.
 7 (2) **The buying, selling, or trading of a motor vehicle that is a**
 8 **motorcycle (as defined in IC 9-13-2-108).**
 9 (b) A person who engages in the business of buying, selling, or
 10 trading motor vehicles on Sunday commits a Class B misdemeanor.
