Whereas, In order to ensure that our current laws adequately protect Hoosiers, it is necessary to determine if state patent laws should be created: Therefore,

*Be it resolved by the Senate of the

- 1 SECTION 1. That the legislative council is urged to establish an
- 2 interim study committee to study the creation of a state patent law.
- 3 SECTION 2. That the committee, if established, shall operate
- 4 under the direction of the legislative council, and that the committee
- 5 shall issue a final report when directed to do so by the council.
