Summary of Legislation: The bill prohibits the Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) from denying a permit for transporting heavy vehicles and loads or nonconforming objects solely on the basis that the vehicle will be transporting a nondivisible load.

Effective Date: July 1, 2012.

Explanation of State Expenditures:

Explanation of State Revenues: INDOT is currently able to issue permits for nondivisible loads that are oversize or overweight. However, this bill would require INDOT to issue permits for all nondivisible loads which exceed size and weight requirements (up to 120,000 pounds).

If additional oversize and overweight permits are issued for nondivisible loads under this provision, additional permit fees would be collected. Oversize permit fees range from \$20 to \$40 for a single trip. Overweight permits for a single trip cost \$20 plus \$0.35 per mile for vehicles up to 108,000 pounds and \$0.60 per mile for vehicles up to 150,000 pounds. Special vehicle permit fees are deposited in the State Highway Fund.
