**IMPACT:** State

**Summary of Legislation:** (Amended) The bill defines logistics for purposes of IC 5-22-2 concerning public purchasing.

The bill authorizes the Department of Transportation (INDOT) to adopt rules to establish and designate a highway as an extra heavy duty highway. (Under current law, extra heavy duty highways are designated by statute.) It requires INDOT to include in the rules: (1) highways designated by statute as extra heavy duty highways; and (2) statutory size and weight limits. It provides that statutory extra heavy duty highway designations and size and weight limits expire on the date on which INDOT's rules are finally adopted.

**Effective Date:** July 1, 2012.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** (Revised) Adopting administrative rules to establish and designate highways as extra heavy duty highways can be accomplished under INDOT's existing level of resources.
