MR. SPEAKER:

*Your Committee on Judiciary, to which was referred House Bill 1133, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
- 2 paragraph and insert:
- 3 "SECTION 1. IC 32-36-1-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 4 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2012]: Sec. 1. (a) This chapter
- 5 applies to an act or event that occurs within Indiana, regardless of a
- 6 personality's domicile, residence, or citizenship.
- 7 (b) This chapter does not affect rights and privileges recognized
- 8 under any other law that apply to a news reporting or an entertainment
- 9 medium.
- 10 (c) This chapter does not apply to the following:
- 11 (1) The use of a personality's name, voice, signature, photograph,
- 12 image, likeness, distinctive appearance, gestures, or mannerisms
- 13 in any of the following:
- 14 (A) Literary works, theatrical works, musical compositions,
- 15 film, radio, or television programs.

- 1 (B) Material that has political or newsworthy value.
 2 (C) Original works of fine art.
 3 (D) Promotional material or an advertisement for a news
 4 reporting or an entertainment medium that:
 5 (i) uses all or part of a past edition of the medium's own
 6 broadcast or publication; and
 7 (ii) does not convey or reasonably suggest that a personality
 8 endorses the news reporting or entertainment medium.
 9 (E) An advertisement or commercial announcement for a use
 10 described in this subdivision.
- 11 (2) The use of a personality's name to truthfully identify the
 12 personality as:
 13 (A) the author of a written work; or
 14 (B) a performer of a recorded performance;
 15 under circumstances in which the written work or recorded
 16 performance is otherwise rightfully reproduced, exhibited, or
 17 broadcast.
- 18 (3) The use of a personality's:
 19 (A) name;
 20 (B) voice;
 21 (C) signature;
 22 (D) photograph;
 23 (E) image;
 24 (F) likeness;
 25 (G) distinctive appearance;
 26 (H) gestures; or
 27 (I) mannerisms;
 28 in connection with the broadcast or reporting of an event or a
 29 topic of general or public interest.
- 30 **(4) A personality whose:**
 31 **(A) name;**
 32 **(B) voice;**
 33 **(C) signature;**
 34 **(D) photograph;**
 35 **(E) image;**
 36 **(F) likeness;**
 37 **(G) distinctive appearance;**
 38 **(H) gesture; or**

- 1 **(I) mannerisms;**
- 2 **has commercial value solely because the personality has been**
- 3 **formally charged with or convicted of a crime."**
- 4 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
 (Reference is to HB 1133 as introduced.)
