A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning civil procedure.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 30-5-8-5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
2 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2012]: Sec. 5. A copy of the power of attorney  
3 has the same force and effect as the original power of attorney if the  
4 attorney in fact **or the person granting the power of attorney**  
5 certifies that the copy is a true and correct copy.
