

SENATE BILL No. 267

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-19-3-11.

Synopsis: Education concerning child abuse. Requires the department of education, in collaboration with organizations that have expertise in child sexual abuse, to identify or develop model education materials, response policies, and reporting procedures on child sexual abuse.

Effective: July 1, 2012.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 20-19-3-11 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2012]: **Sec. 11. (a) The department, in collaboration with
4 organizations that have expertise in child sexual abuse, shall
5 identify or develop:**
6 (1) **model educational materials on child sexual abuse; and**
7 (2) **a model for child sexual abuse response policies and
8 reporting procedures.**
9 (b) **Not later than July 1, 2013, the department shall make the
10 models developed or identified under this section available to assist
11 schools with the implementation of:**
12 (1) **child sexual abuse education programs in prekindergarten
13 through grade 5; and**
14 (2) **child sexual abuse response and reporting policies.**
15 (c) **The model educational materials on child sexual abuse
16 identified or developed under subsection (a) may include the
17 following topics:**



- 1 **(1) Warning signs of a child who is being sexually abused.**
- 2 **(2) The basic principles of child sexual abuse prevention.**
- 3 **(3) Methods of student, teacher, and parental education and**
- 4 **outreach.**
- 5 **(d) The model child sexual abuse response and reporting policies**
- 6 **referred to in subsection (b) may include the following topics:**
- 7 **(1) Actions that a child who is a victim of sexual abuse may**
- 8 **take to obtain assistance.**
- 9 **(2) Interventions.**
- 10 **(3) Counseling options.**
- 11 **(4) Educational support available for a child who is a victim**
- 12 **of sexual abuse to continue to be successful in school.**
- 13 **(5) Reporting procedures.**

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
