**Synopsis:** Duration of school superintendent contracts. Reduces the minimum duration, from 36 months to 12 months, of a contract between a governing body and a superintendent of a school corporation.

# HOUSE BILL No. 1138



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 20-28-8-6, AS ADDED BY P.L.1-2005, SECTION
- 2 12, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1,
- 3 2012]: Sec. 6. A contract entered into by a governing body and its
- 4 superintendent is subject to the following conditions:
- 5 (1) The basic contract must be in the form of the regular teacher's
- 6 contract.
- 7 (2) **If the contract: ~~must be for:~~**
- 8 **(A) is entered into before July 1, 2012, the contract must**
- 9 **have a term of at least thirty-six (36) months; or**
- 10 **(B) is entered into after June 30, 2012, the contract must**
- 11 **have a term of at least twelve (12) months.**
- 12 (3) The contract may be altered or rescinded for a new one at any
- 13 time by mutual consent of the governing body and the
- 14 superintendent. The consent of both parties must be in writing and
- 15 must be expressed in a manner consistent with this section and
- 16 sections 7 through 8 of this chapter.
- 17 (4) The rights of a superintendent as a teacher under any other law
