

SENATE MOTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 12 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 6, between lines 11 and 12, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 5. IC 12-7-2-25, AS AMENDED BY P.L.143-2011,
3 SECTION 3, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
4 JULY 1, 2012]: Sec. 25. (a) **"Case management", for purposes of**
5 **IC 12-9-5-3.5, has the meaning set forth in IC 12-9-5-3.5(a).**
6 (b) "Case management", for purposes of IC 12-10-1 and
7 IC 12-10-10, has the meaning set forth in IC 12-10-10-1."
8 Page 20, between lines 12 and 13, begin a new paragraph and insert:
9 "SECTION 22. IC 12-9-5-3.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
10 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
11 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2012]: **Sec. 3.5. (a) As used in this section,**
12 **"case management" means the provision of assistance and support**
13 **to an individual to develop community connections for the**
14 **individual. Case management fosters the use of natural supports**
15 **for an individual receiving services. For adults, case management**
16 **assists the individual in finding a career path that leads to**
17 **employment.**
18 (b) **The case manager is responsible for the appropriate use of**
19 **resources in assisting an individual with obtaining and maintaining**
20 **Medicaid and other appropriate resources. Case management**
21 **services, provided either directly or under a contract with the**
22 **division, must be provided by an individual who is independent of:**
23 (1) **the division; and**
24 (2) **any entity providing to the individual services that are not**
25 **case management services.**
26 (c) **If the division contracts for the provision of case**
27 **management services, the division shall enter into a contract with**
28 **more than one (1) provider so that an individual receiving case**
29 **management services has a choice of providers, regardless of**
30 **where the individual is located in Indiana, and to ensure that**

1 services are provided in an independent manner.
2 (d) If, after June 30, 2012, the division contracts for the
3 provision of case management services, any contract entered into
4 may not be for a term that exceeds one (1) year, with a maximum
5 of one (1) renewal for a one (1) year term, without rebidding the
6 contract or contracts.
7 (e) Each year the division shall report to the commission on
8 developmental disabilities created by IC 2-5-27.2-1 on the
9 provision of case management services to individuals receiving
10 services from the division. The report must include information on:
11 (1) the number of contracts entered into for the provision of
12 case management services;
13 (2) the number of clients served; and
14 (3) feedback on the clients' satisfaction with the availability
15 and appropriateness of case management services received."
16 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
