

COMMITTEE REPORT

MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Corrections, Criminal, and Civil Matters, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 4, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
2 paragraph and insert:
3 "SECTION 1. IC 5-14-3-5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
4 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 5. (a) If a person
5 is arrested or summoned for an offense, the following information shall
6 be made available for inspection and copying:
7 (1) Information that identifies the person including the person's
8 name, age, and address.
9 (2) Information concerning any charges on which the arrest or
10 summons is based.
11 (3) Information relating to the circumstances of the arrest or the
12 issuance of the summons, such as the:
13 (A) time and location of the arrest or the issuance of the
14 summons;
15 (B) investigating or arresting officer (other than an undercover
16 officer or agent); and
17 (C) investigating or arresting law enforcement agency.
18 (b) If a person is received in a jail or lock-up, the following
19 information shall be made available for inspection and copying:
20 (1) Information that identifies the person including the person's
21 name, age, and address.

- 1 (2) Information concerning the reason for the person being placed
 2 in the jail or lock-up, including the name of the person on whose
 3 order the person is being held.
 4 (3) The time and date that the person was received and the time
 5 and date of the person's discharge or transfer.
 6 (4) The amount of the person's bail or bond, if it has been fixed.
 7 (c) An agency shall maintain a daily log or record that lists
 8 suspected crimes, accidents, or complaints, and the following
 9 information shall be made available for inspection and copying:
 10 (1) The time, substance, and location of all complaints or requests
 11 for assistance received by the agency.
 12 (2) The time and nature of the agency's response to all complaints
 13 or requests for assistance.
 14 (3) If the incident involves an alleged crime or infraction:
 15 (A) the time, date, and location of occurrence;
 16 (B) the name and age of any victim, unless the victim is a
 17 victim of a crime under IC 35-42-4 **or IC 35-42-3.5**;
 18 (C) the factual circumstances surrounding the incident; and
 19 (D) a general description of any injuries, property, or weapons
 20 involved.
 21 The information required in this subsection shall be made available for
 22 inspection and copying in compliance with this chapter. The record
 23 containing the information must be created not later than twenty-four
 24 (24) hours after the suspected crime, accident, or complaint has been
 25 reported to the agency.
 26 (d) This chapter does not affect IC 5-2-4, IC 10-13-3, or
 27 IC 5-11-1-9."
 28 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
 (Reference is to SB 4 as introduced.)
