

COMMITTEE REPORT

MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Education and Career Development, to which was referred House Bill No. 1200, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

- 1 Page 1, line 5, delete "a Research" and insert "**an RU/VH**
- 2 **(Research"**.
- 3 Page 1, line 5, after "high" insert "**research activity)) or an RU/H**
- 4 **(Research University (high research activity))"**.
- 5 Page 1, delete line 6.
- 6 Page 1, run in lines 5 through 7.
- 7 Page 1, between lines 8 and 9, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 8 "SECTION 2. IC 21-19-3-3, AS ADDED BY P.L.2-2007, SECTION
- 9 260, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 10 JANUARY 1, 2012 (RETROACTIVE)]: Sec. 3. Not more than six (6)
- 11 of the nonstudent members of the board of trustees may be of the same
- 12 sex. ~~At least one (1) member of the board of trustees must be a resident~~
- 13 ~~of and reside in Delaware County."~~
- 14 Page 4, between lines 16 and 17, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 15 "SECTION 13. IC 21-38-3-1, AS ADDED BY P.L.2-2007,
- 16 SECTION 279, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 17 [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 1. (a) This section applies to the
- 18 board of trustees of the following state educational institutions:
- 19 (1) Ball State University.
- 20 (2) Indiana University.

- 1 (3) Indiana State University.
- 2 (4) Purdue University.
- 3 (5) University of Southern Indiana.
- 4 (b) The board of trustees of a state educational institution may
- 5 employ:
- 6 (1) officers;
- 7 (2) faculty;
- 8 (3) employees;
- 9 (4) consultants; and
- 10 (5) counsel;

11 necessary or convenient to aid in the formulation and implementation
 12 of the state educational institution's policies and to execute the will of
 13 the board of trustees within its particular institution.

14 **(c) This subsection does not apply to the board of trustees with**
 15 **respect to a:**

- 16 **(1) member of a fire department established; or**
- 17 **(2) police officer appointed;**
- 18 **by the board of trustees of a state educational institution. The**
- 19 **board of trustees may not impose or allow any mandatory or**
- 20 **presumptive age limits in the hiring, the retention in a position, or**
- 21 **the continuation of employment of any employee of the institution**
- 22 **described under subsection (b)(1), (b)(2), or (b)(5)."**

23 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
