DIGEST OF SB 205 (Updated March 27, 2013 3:49 pm - DI 69)

Citations Affected: IC 13-26.

Synopsis: Regional water, sewage, and solid waste districts. Provides that an appointed trustee of the board of directors of a regional water, sewage, or solid waste district may be a ratepayer of the district. Allows a member of the board of certain regional water and sewage districts to receive not more than \$125 per day for each day or major part of a day the member devotes to the work of the district (instead of not more than \$50 per day).

Effective: July 1, 2013.

ENGROSSED SENATE BILL No. 205

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning environmental law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 13-26-4-6, AS AMENDED BY P.L.97-2012,
2 SECTION 6, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 6. (a) This section does not apply to a district
4 described in section 6.1 of this chapter.

5 (b) An appointed trustee does not have to be a resident of the
6 district.

7 (c) An appointed trustee must:
8 (1) own real property within the district;
9 (2) be a trustee appointed under section 4 or 5 of this chapter; **or**
10 (3) be an elected official who represents a political subdivision
11 that has territory in the district; **or**
12 **(4) be a ratepayer of the district.**

Mr. Speaker: Your Committee on Environmental Affairs, to which was referred Senate Bill 205, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill be amended as follows:

Page 1, after line 12, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"SECTION 2. IC 13-26-4-7 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 7. (a) **Except as provided in subsection (b)**, the board of a district may provide for the payment of not more than fifty dollars (\$50) per day to members of the board for each day or major part of a day devoted to the work of the district.

(b) This subsection applies only to a regional water and sewage district that:

- (1) is located in more than one (1) county; and**
- (2) was formed in 1975 by order of the stream pollution control board of the state of Indiana (which was succeeded by the water pollution control board in 1986).**

The board of a district may provide for the payment of not more than one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125) per day to members of the board for each day or major part of a day devoted to the work of the district.

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(~~e~~) **(d)** Payments made to board members under subsections (a), ~~and~~ (b), **and (c)** shall be made from the general fund of the district."
