Summary of Legislation: This bill requires a student who attends a nonpublic high school that is not a member of an interscholastic athletic association but who participates in high school athletics at a public high school that is a member of an athletic association to: (1) follow applicable code of conduct rules; (2) fulfill certain academic requirements; (3) undergo annual Department of Education-approved academic assessments; and (4) comply with any transfer rules of the association.

Effective Date: July 1, 2013.
