Summary of Legislation: (Amended) This bill provides that county ordinances governing sanitation standards do not include standards governing, and do not apply to, the installation, permitting, and maintenance of onsite residential sewage disposal systems as enforced by the State Department of Health or a local health department. It provides that the private home exemption from certain construction standards adopted by local ordinance does not extend to rules and regulations adopted by health departments governing sanitation standards.
