IMPACT: Local

Summary of Legislation: (Amended) This bill provides that an appointed trustee of the board of directors of a regional water, sewage, or solid waste district may be a ratepayer of the district. The bill also allows a member of the board of certain regional water and sewage districts to receive not more than \$125 per day for each day or major part of a day the member devotes to the work of the district (instead of not more than \$50 per day).

Effective Date: July 1, 2013.

Explanation of Local Expenditures: (Revised) The bill provides that board members of certain regional water and sewer districts may receive a maximum of \$125 per day for district work instead of a maximum of \$50 per day under current statute.
