Summary of Legislation: (Amended) This bill specifies that the Indiana Sportsmen's Benevolence account administered by the Department of Natural Resources (DNR), Division of Law Enforcement, is a nonreverting account.

Effective Date: July 1, 2013.

Explanation of State Expenditures:

Explanation of State Revenues: (Revised) The Indiana Sportsmen's Benevolence account is administered by the DNR, Division of Law Enforcement. Its purpose is to encourage citizen participation in feeding the state's hungry through donations of wild game.
