**Summary of Legislation:** This bill requires the Data Division of the Indiana State Police Department (ISP) to notify the Indiana Criminal Justice Institute (ICJI) if a public official or agency dealing with crime or criminals fails to comply with its statutory reporting duties. The bill permits the ICJI to withhold certain funds from a public official or agency that has failed to comply with its reporting requirements, and permits the institute to reinstate withheld funds if the public official or agency complies with reporting requirements within six months of the funds being withheld.
