MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 403 be amended to read as follows:

- 1           Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new  
2 paragraph and insert:  
3           "SECTION 1. IC 9-13-2-196.5, AS ADDED BY P.L.58-2006,  
4 SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
5 JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 196.5. (a) "Veteran", for purposes of IC 9-18-50,  
6 has the meaning set forth in IC 9-18-50-1.  
7           **(b) "Veteran", for purposes of IC 9-18-55, has the meaning set**  
8 **forth in IC 9-18-55-1.**  
9           SECTION 2. IC 9-18-15-1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.87-2010,  
10 SECTION 10, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
11 JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 1. (a) A person who is the registered owner or  
12 lessee of a:  
13           (1) passenger motor vehicle;  
14           (2) motorcycle;  
15           (3) recreational vehicle; or  
16           (4) vehicle registered as a truck with a declared gross weight of  
17 not more than eleven thousand (11,000) pounds;  
18 registered with the bureau or who makes an application for an original  
19 registration or renewal registration of a vehicle may apply to the bureau  
20 for a personalized license plate to be affixed to the vehicle for which  
21 registration is sought instead of the regular license plate.  
22           (b) A person who:  
23           (1) is the registered owner or lessee of a vehicle described in  
24 subsection (a); and

- 1 (2) is eligible to receive a license plate for the vehicle under:  
2 (A) IC 9-18-17 (prisoner of war license plates);  
3 (B) IC 9-18-18 (disabled Hoosier veteran license plates);

10 (I) IC 9-18-24.5 (In God We Trust license plates);  
11 (J) IC 9-18-25 (special group recognition license plates);

2 Page 2, after line 11, begin a new paragraph and insert:  
3 "SECTION 4. IC 9-18-25-1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.87-2010,  
4 SECTION 18, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
5 JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 1. This chapter does not apply to the following:  
6 (1) Antique motor vehicle license plates (IC 9-18-12).  
7 (2) Recovery vehicle license plates (IC 9-18-13).  
8 (3) Personalized license plates (IC 9-18-15).  
9 (4) Prisoner of war license plates (IC 9-18-17).  
10 (5) Disabled Hoosier veteran license plates (IC 9-18-18).  
11 (6) Purple Heart license plates (IC 9-18-19).  
12 (7) Indiana National Guard license plates (IC 9-18-20).  
13 (8) Person with a disability license plates (IC 9-18-22).  
14 (9) Amateur radio operator license plates (IC 9-18-23).

22 SECTION 5. IC 9-18-55 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS  
23 A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY  
24 1, 2013]:  
25 **Chapter 55. Vietnam Veterans Trust License Plates**  
26 **Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "veteran" refers to an individual**  
27 **who served as a member of the armed forces of the United States**  
28 **at any time from August 5, 1964, through May 7, 1975 (Vietnam**  
29 **Conflict).**  
30 **Sec. 2. The bureau shall design a Vietnam veterans trust license**  
31 **plate to be issued beginning January 1, 2014.**  
32 **Sec. 3. A Vietnam veterans trust license plate must include the**  
33 **following:**  
34 **(1) A basic design for the plate with consecutive numbers or**  
35 **letters, or both, to properly identify the vehicle.**  
36 **(2) A background design or colors that designate the license**  
37 **plate as a Vietnam veterans trust license plate.**  
38 **(3) Any other information the bureau considers necessary.**  
39 **Sec. 4. The bureau shall confer with members of armed forces**  
40 **retiree organizations concerning the design of the Vietnam**  
41 **veterans trust license plate and the emblems denoting the branch**  
42 **of service or conflict in which the veteran served.**  
43 **Sec. 5. A Vietnam veterans trust license plate issued under this**  
44 **chapter may be displayed on the following:**  
45 **(1) A passenger motor vehicle.**  
46 **(2) A truck registered as a truck with a declared gross weight**

1 of not more than eleven thousand (11,000) pounds.  
 2 (3) A recreational vehicle.  
 3 (4) A motorcycle.  
 4 **Sec. 6. A veteran who is a resident of Indiana and eligible to**  
 5 **register a vehicle listed in section 5 of this chapter may apply for**  
 6 **and receive a Vietnam veterans trust license plate for one (1) or**  
 7 **more vehicles upon doing the following:**  
 8 (1) **Completing an application for a Vietnam veterans trust**  
 9 **license plate.**  
 10 (2) **Presenting:**  
 11 (A) **a United States Uniformed Services Retiree**  
 12 **Identification Card;**  
 13 (B) **a DD 214 record;**  
 14 (C) **United States military discharge papers; or**  
 15 (D) **a current armed forces identification card;**  
 16 **to the bureau.**  
 17 (3) **Paying the fees under section 7 of this chapter.**  
 18 **Sec. 7. The fees for a Vietnam veterans trust license plate are set**  
 19 **forth in IC 9-29-5-38.7.**  
 20 SECTION 6. IC 9-29-5-38.7 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE  
 21 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY  
 22 1, 2013]: **Sec. 38.7. A vehicle registered under IC 9-18-55 is subject**  
 23 **to:**  
 24 (1) **an annual registration fee;**  
 25 (2) **any other fee or tax required of a person registering a**  
 26 **vehicle under this title."**  
 27 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.  
 (Reference is to SB 403 as printed March 22, 2013.)
