MR. SPEAKER:

*Your Committee on Environmental Affairs, to which was referred Senate Bill 205, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Page 1, after line 12, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 2. IC 13-26-4-7 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 3 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 7. (a) **Except as**
- 4 **provided in subsection (b)**, the board of a district may provide for the
- 5 payment of not more than fifty dollars (\$50) per day to members of the
- 6 board for each day or major part of a day devoted to the work of the
- 7 district.
- 8 **(b) This subsection applies only to a regional water and sewage**
- 9 **district that:**
- 10 **(1) is located in more than one (1) county; and**
- 11 **(2) was formed in 1975 by order of the stream pollution**
- 12 **control board of the state of Indiana (which was succeeded by**
- 13 **the water pollution control board in 1986).**
- 14 **The board of a district may provide for the payment of not more**
- 15 **than one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125) per day to members**
- 16 **of the board for each day or major part of a day devoted to the**

1 **work of the district.**

2 ~~(b)~~ **(c)** Members of the board are entitled to receive an amount for
3 travel expenses equal to the amount paid to state employees for
4 expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.

5 ~~(c)~~ **(d)** Payments made to board members under subsections (a), ~~and~~
6 (b), **and (c)** shall be made from the general fund of the district."
