A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning professions and occupations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

 40 license to each licensee at least sixty (60) days prior to the expiration
 41 of the license. The notice must inform the licensee of the need to renew
 42 and the requirement of payment of the renewal fee. If this notice of

1 expiration is not sent by the entity, the licensee is not subject to a
 2 sanction for failure to renew if, once notice is received from the entity,
 3 the license is renewed within forty-five (45) days of the receipt of the
 4 notice.

5 (d) Notwithstanding any other law, the entities included in
 6 subsection (b) shall send notice of the expiration of a license to each
 7 individual whose license has expired within thirty (30) days following
 8 the expiration of the license. The notice must meet the following
 9 requirements:

10 (1) Inform the individual of the following:

11 (A) That the individual's license has expired.

12 (B) Any requirements that must be met before reinstatement
 13 of a license may occur.

14 (2) Be sent electronically. However, if the entity does not have an
 15 electronic mail address on record for the individual, the notice
 16 must be sent via United States mail.

25 **Chapter 1. Definitions**

26 **Sec. 1. The definitions in this chapter apply throughout this**
 27 **article.**

28 **Sec. 2. "Agency" refers to the Indiana professional licensing**
 29 **agency established by IC 25-1-5-3.**

30 **Sec. 3. "Board" refers to the Indiana diabetes educators board**
 31 **established by IC 25-14.3-2-1.**

32 **Sec. 4. "Diabetes education" means a collaborative process**
 33 **through which persons with or at risk for diabetes gain the**
 34 **knowledge and skills needed to modify behavior and successfully**
 35 **self-manage diabetes and conditions related to diabetes.**

36 **Sec. 5. "Licensed diabetes educator" refers to an individual who**
 37 **is licensed under this article.**

38 **Chapter 2. Indiana Diabetes Educators Board**

39 **Sec. 1. The Indiana diabetes educators board is established.**

40 **Sec. 2. The board consists of five (5) members appointed by the**
 41 **governor as follows:**

- 42 **(1) One (1) member who is a physician licensed under**

- 7 **IC 25-14.5.**
- 8 **(5) One (1) member who is a citizen at large who is not**
- 9 **employed in the health care field.**
- 10 **One (1) of the members appointed under subdivisions (2) through**
- 11 **(4) must have completed either the credentialing program of the**
- 12 **American Association of Diabetes Educators or the National**
- 13 **Certification Board for Diabetes Educators.**
- 14 **Sec. 3. Each member of the board serves a term of four (4) years**
- 15 **or until a successor is appointed. The governor shall initially**
- 16 **appoint:**
- 17 **(1) two (2) members for a term of four (4) years;**
- 18 **(2) two (2) members for a term of three (3) years; and**
- 19 **(3) one (1) member for a term of two (2) years.**
- 20 **Sec. 4. A member may not serve for more than two (2)**
- 21 **consecutive terms.**
- 22 **Sec. 5. The board shall organize annually and elect one (1) of the**
- 23 **members as chairperson and one (1) of the members as secretary.**
- 24 **Sec. 6. A quorum consists of three (3) members.**
- 25 **Sec. 7. The board shall meet at least semiannually and upon the**
- 26 **call of the chairperson or at the request of two (2) members.**
- 27 **Sec. 8. (a) The board shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2**
- 28 **establishing:**
- 29 **(1) standards for professional responsibility or a code of ethics**
- 30 **for the profession of diabetes educator;**
- 31 **(2) standards of practice that are based upon policies and**
- 32 **positions adopted by the American Association of Diabetes**
- 33 **Educators; and**
- 34 **(3) standards for continuing education requirements for**
- 35 **diabetes educators.**
- 36 **(b) The board shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to establish fees**

1 (c) The board shall investigate alleged violations brought under
 2 this article, conduct investigations, and schedule and conduct
 3 administrative hearings under IC 4-21.5.

4 (d) The board shall keep a record of:

- 5 (1) the proceedings of the board; and
 6 (2) all individuals licensed by the board.

7 **Chapter 3. License Requirements**

8 **Sec. 1. (a)** After July 1, 2014, a person may not use the title of
 9 "licensed diabetes educator" or profess to be a licensed diabetes
 10 educator unless the person holds a license under this article.

11 (b) This section does not apply to a person licensed, certified, or
 12 registered under any other provision of this title, including:

- 13 (1) a physician licensed under IC 25-22.5;
 14 (2) a nurse licensed under IC 25-23;
 15 (3) a pharmacist licensed under IC 25-26;
 16 (4) a dietitian certified under IC 25-14.5; and
 17 (5) a student in accredited programs for the provisions listed
 18 in this subsection.

19 However, if a person covered under this subsection uses the title of
 20 "licensed diabetes educator", the person using the title must have
 21 some training in diabetes education in addition to the training
 22 required for the profession for which the person holds a license.

23 **Sec. 2.** An applicant for a license must file a written application
 24 with the board on forms provided by the board.

25 **Sec. 3.** An applicant must provide evidence to the board showing
 26 successful completion of one (1) of the following:

- 27 (1) The American Association of Diabetes Educators core
 28 concepts course with demonstrable experience in the care of
 29 individuals with diabetes under supervision that meets
 30 requirements specified in rules adopted by the board.
 31 (2) The credentialing program of the American Association of
 32 Diabetes Educators or the National Certification Board for
 33 Diabetes Educators.
 34 (3) An equivalent credentialing program as determined by the
 35 board.

36 **Sec. 4.** Requirements established by the board must include a
 37 core body of knowledge and skills in:

- 38 (1) the biological and social sciences;
 39 (2) communication;
 40 (3) counseling;
 41 (4) education; and
 42 (5) experience in the care of individuals with diabetes.

1 **Sec. 5. A license issued under this chapter is valid for two (2)**
2 **years after the date of issuance.**

3 **Sec. 6. The board shall require each licensee to complete**
4 **annually fifteen (15) hours of board approved continuing**
5 **education.**

6 **Chapter 4. License Revocation or Suspension**

7 **Sec. 1. For purposes of this chapter, "unprofessional conduct"**
8 **includes the following:**

9 **(1) Obtaining or attempting to obtain a license by fraud,**
10 **misrepresentation, concealment of material facts, or making**
11 **a false statement to the board.**

12 **(2) Conviction of a felony if the conviction has direct bearing**
13 **on whether the person is trustworthy to serve the public as a**
14 **licensed diabetes educator.**

15 **(3) Violation of any lawful order issued or rule adopted by the**
16 **board.**

17 **Sec. 2. The board may:**

18 **(1) suspend or revoke a license; or**

19 **(2) issue a reprimand;**

20 **if the licensee engages in unprofessional conduct that has**
21 **endangered or is likely to endanger the health, welfare, or safety of**
22 **the public.**

23 **Chapter 5. Unlawful Practices**

24 **Sec. 1. A person who recklessly, knowingly, or intentionally**
25 **violates this article commits a Class A misdemeanor.**
