

# COMMITTEE REPORT

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## MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Appropriations, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 245, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

- 1 Delete the title and insert the following:  
 2 A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning  
 3 criminal law and procedure and to make an appropriation.  
 4 Page 4, between lines 38 and 39, begin a new paragraph and insert:  
 5 "SECTION 4. IC 33-37-5-26.2, AS AMENDED BY P.L.174-2006,  
 6 SECTION 13, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
 7 JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 26.2. (a) In each action in which a person is:  
 8 (1) convicted of an offense;  
 9 (2) required to pay a pretrial diversion fee;  
 10 (3) found to have committed an infraction; or  
 11 (4) found to have violated an ordinance;  
 12 the clerk shall collect a DNA sample processing fee of ~~two dollars (\$2)~~.  
 13 **four dollars (\$4)**.  
 14 SECTION 5. IC 33-37-7-9, AS AMENDED BY P.L.229-2011,  
 15 SECTION 262, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
 16 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2013]: Sec. 9. (a) On June 30 and on December  
 17 31 of each year, the auditor of state shall transfer to the treasurer of  
 18 state nine million ~~two~~ **seven** hundred seventy-seven thousand  
 19 twenty-three dollars (~~\$9,277,023~~) (**\$9,777,023**) for distribution under  
 20 subsection (b).  
 21 (b) On June 30 and on December 31 of each year, the treasurer of

1 state shall deposit into:

2 (1) the family violence and victim assistance fund established by  
3 IC 5-2-6.8-3 an amount equal to ~~eight and three hundredths seven~~  
4 **and sixty-two hundredths** percent (~~8.03%~~); **(7.62%)**;

5 (2) the Indiana judges' retirement fund established by  
6 IC 33-38-6-12 an amount equal to ~~thirty-eight and fifty-five~~  
7 **hundredths thirty-six and fifty-eight hundredths** percent  
8 (~~38.55%~~); **(36.58%)**;

9 (3) the law enforcement academy building fund established by  
10 IC 5-2-1-13 an amount equal to ~~two and fifty-six hundredths two~~  
11 **and forty-three hundredths** percent (~~2.56%~~); **(2.43%)**;

12 (4) the law enforcement training fund established by IC 5-2-1-13  
13 an amount equal to ~~ten and twenty-seven hundredths nine and~~  
14 **seven-four hundredths** percent (~~10.27%~~); **(9.74%)**;

15 (5) the violent crime victims compensation fund established by  
16 IC 5-2-6.1-40 an amount equal to ~~eleven and ninety-three~~  
17 **hundredths eleven and thirty-two hundredths** percent (~~11.93%~~);  
18 **(11.32%)**;

19 (6) the motor vehicle highway account an amount equal to  
20 ~~nineteen and forty-nine hundredths eighteen and forty-nine~~  
21 **hundredths** percent (~~19.49%~~); **(18.49%)**;

22 (7) the fish and wildlife fund established by IC 14-22-3-2 an  
23 amount equal to ~~twenty-five hundredths twenty-four hundredths~~  
24 **percent (0.25%); (0.24%)**;

25 (8) the Indiana judicial center drug and alcohol programs fund  
26 established by IC 12-23-14-17 for the administration,  
27 certification, and support of alcohol and drug services programs  
28 under IC 12-23-14 an amount equal to ~~one and sixty-three~~  
29 **hundredths one and fifty-five hundredths** percent (~~1.63%~~);  
30 **(1.55%)**; and

31 (9) the DNA sample processing fund established under  
32 IC 10-13-6-9.5 for the funding of the collection, shipment,  
33 analysis, and preservation of DNA samples and the conduct of a  
34 DNA data base program under IC 10-13-6 an amount equal to  
35 ~~seven and twenty-nine hundredths twelve and three hundredths~~  
36 **percent (7.29%); (12.03%)**;

37 of the amount transferred by the auditor of state under subsection (a).

38 (c) On June 30 and on December 31 of each year, the auditor of  
39 state shall transfer to the treasurer of state for deposit into the public

- 1 defense fund established under IC 33-40-6-1 three million seven
- 2 hundred thousand dollars (\$3,700,000).".
- 3 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.  
(Reference is to SB 245 as printed February 8, 2013.)

**and when so amended that said bill do pass .**
