 - (B) An individual laid off for more than 59 days or without a specific recall date.
 - (C) An individual using:
 - (1) a union hiring service;
 - (2) a referral service; or
 - (3) another DWD approved job placement service.
 - (D) An individual attending DWD-approved training or retraining.
- (7) The state's compliance with each of the recommendations and requirements in the United States Department of Labor (DOL), Employment and Training Administration (ETA), Training and Employment Guidance Letter No. 2-09 (Approved Training for the Unemployment Insurance Program Recommended Policies). (See Enclosure #7 sent to Committee members.)
- (8) The state's compliance with each of the recommendations and requirements in DOL, ETA, Unemployment Insurance Program Letter No. 34-09 (Best Practices for Payment of Unemployment Compensation by Debit Cards). (See Enclosure #8 sent to Committee members.)
- (9) Committee discussion concerning topics assigned to the Committee and meeting agenda items.
- (10) Public testimony concerning topics assigned to the Committee and meeting agenda items (limited to a total of 30 minutes and 3 minutes per witness).
